



## Walnut Valley Water District Approves Rate Increases

The Walnut Valley Water District's Board of Directors approved increases in the commodity rates.

- *These increases will go into effect **April 1, 2011** for: Commercial, industrial, governmental, and multi-family customers.*
- *With ongoing cost savings the District has achieved, the increases are lower than originally projected.*
- *The monthly base rate and pump zone charges will remain unchanged.*

The District strives to keep rates fair and equitable and to promote water conservation and financial stability by only generating sufficient revenues to cover the cost-of-service: including funds for capital projects, replacement of aging infrastructure, and other needed expenses.

Potable Commodity Rate	Current Rate	New Rates <i>(Effective April 1, 2011)</i>
Multi-family Residential	\$2.06 per unit	<b>\$2.23 per unit</b>
Commercial/Industrial/Governmental	\$2.10 per unit	<b>\$2.34 per unit</b>

There are no changes to the monthly base and the pump zone charges.

*One unit is equal to approximately 748 gallons of water*
