

DISTRICT RATE REMAINS CONSTANT COMMODITY RATE INCREASES

It remains an on-going mission of the Walnut Valley Water District to maintain the lowest water rates possible for its customers. The District has been firmly committed to keeping its internal costs down and has, therefore, taken great pride in not increasing its delivery charge since 1992.

However, due to the continued rising regulatory and importer costs, coupled with increasing costs that the District must pay to purchase treated water from Three Valleys Municipal Water District, the District is left with no recourse other than to increase its Commodity Rate. The 7-cent increase in the total Commodity Rate, from \$1.68 to \$1.75 per unit (hundred cubic feet), will cover these costs. This adjustment will first appear on your August water bill for water used during the previous billing period.

Please be assured that the District remains dedicated to providing high quality water and service to its customers and will remain ever vigilant in maintaining the lowest possible water rate.
