The 20-Gallon challenge is a call for customers to reduce water use by 20 gallons per day. Below are some helpful tips to achieve this goal.

OUTDOOR DAILY SAVINGS

- ◆ Water your yard before 8 a.m. or after 5 p.m. and save up to 20 gallons.
- ◆ Install a new “smart” sprinkler controller and save up to 40 gallons.
- ◆ Adjust your sprinklers properly and save up to 20 gallons.
- ◆ Install a pool cover to reduce evaporation and save up to 30 gallons.

INDOOR DAILY SAVINGS

- ◆ Take a five minute shower and save up to 5 gallons.
- ◆ Fix leaky faucets and save up to 20 gallons.
- ◆ Turn off water while brushing your teeth and save up to 8 gallons.
